The Performing Arts guidance (page 12) still remains somewhat vague; they use the word "may" in relationship to mask wearing and testing. There is no word regarding spacing for audience seating. I know in my county, there will be a meeting with our local DOH and our school superintendents. I recommend that you go to your district for further clarity.
